

Required documents for Korean Government Scholarship Program (KGSP) applicants for KAIST

**MANDATORY:** ①, ②, ③

① **Secondary / Tertiary School Profile**

Official school profile/introduction/brochures published by the applicant's high school or the Ministry of Education. Otherwise, you may submit School's website, GPA rating system, college acceptance statistics, curricula or any other relevant information that would help us understand your school better.

② **Standardized official test scores**

At least one of the official test score reports as follows: High School leaving exam, University Entrance exam results, SAT 1, SAT 2, AP, IB, GCE A-Level, ACT, and certificate of International Olympiad

High school leaving exam or University entrance exam	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>As for High school leaving exam or University entrance exam, please describe the exam in A4 one-page including information such as exam date, subjects, grading procedure, results, etc.</li></ul>
<b>SAT2 (Recommended)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>We recommend, if possible, the applicants to take SAT 2(subject test) for three subjects: 1) Math Level 2, 2) Physics, and 3) Chemistry (or Biology).</li></ul>

<p>Online Reporting (SAT1,SAT2, ACT, and AP)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• SAT1, SAT2, ACT, and AP Official test results can be sent directly from the testing agency to KAIST. Online reporting normally takes <u>4weeks</u> to receive the score from the College Board. Please meet the document submission deadline.</li> <li>• If the highest results for each category are spread over multiple examination dates, applicants may send <u>multiple examination results</u>. The highest grades will be considered for each examination category.</li> <li>• <b>KAIST Institution Code</b> SAT 1, SAT2, AP : 4433 ACT:7778</li> </ul>
<p>IB/ GCE A-Level</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>IB or GCE A-Level Final Score:</b> If you have your final IB or GCE A-Level score, please submit the final one.</li> <li>• <b>IB or GCE A-Level Predicted score:</b> we accept IB predicted score report written by counselor or teacher at the school. Once the applicant is admitted, they must submit IB diploma as soon as they receive it. If there are significant discrepancies between your predicted score and final scores, your admission can be rescinded.</li> </ul>
<p>International Olympiad</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Official test results can be sent directly from the testing agency to KAIST. You may attach a separate sheet to explain the exam procedure, competition rate, results, etc.</li> <li>• Certificate of <u>National</u> Olympiad <b>CANNOT</b> replace Official Test score.</li> </ul>

### ③ Official English Proficiency Test (EPT)

- Candidates whose native language is not English MUST submit one of certificates of official English proficiency test scores: TOEFL iBT 83, TOEFL PBT 560, TOEFL CBT 220, TEPS 599, IELTS 6.5 and TOEIC 720 or higher
- EPT must be taken within two years from the deadline of the KGSP application.
